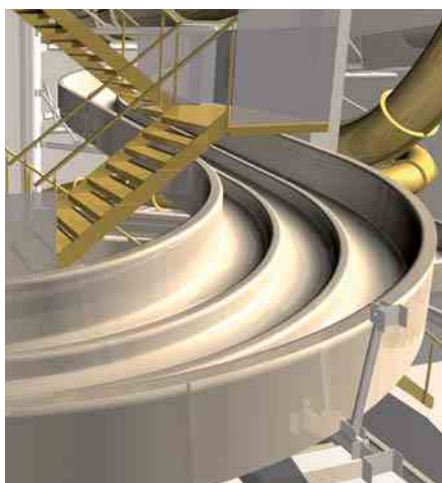

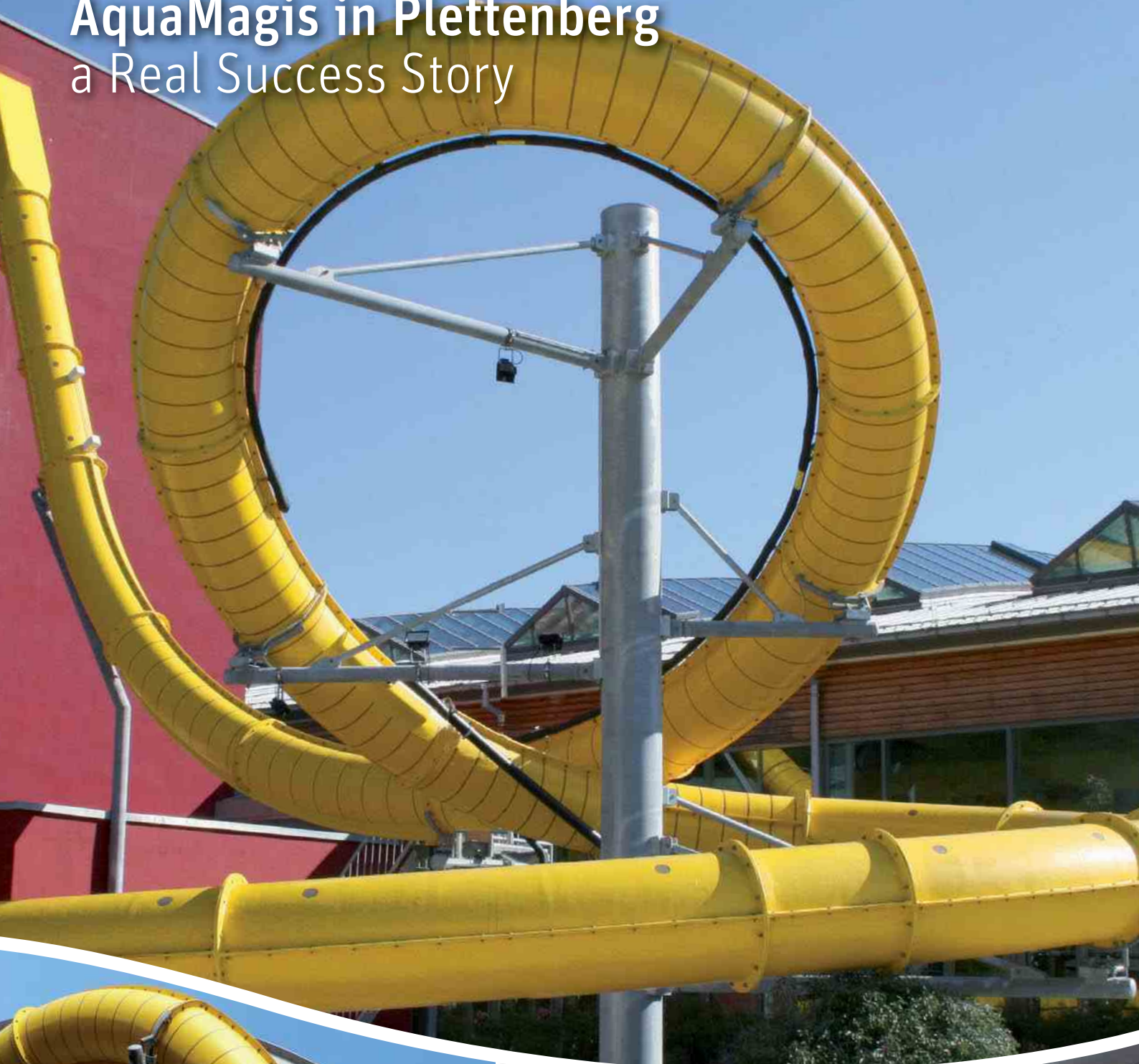

AquaMagis in Plettenberg a Real Success Story



AquaMagis in Plettenberg is among the most well-known and most-visited waterparks in Germany. The long and trusted partnership between Klarer Freizeitanlagen AG and AquaMagis deserves investigation.

Once upon a time, long ago...

... or actually in 2003, Klarer Freizeitanlagen AG was given the contract to plan and build two waterslides for a new waterpark in Plettenberg. The foundation of a long and fruitful partnership was laid.

When an idea becomes reality

The next milestone was reached in 2008, when, after months of developmental work, the first Loop Slide prototype in the world was installed at Klarer Headquarters in Hal-lau, where it could be seen, touched and even tested. One of the first sliders was Dr. Uwe Allmann, the managing director of AquaMagis in Plettenberg. He wasted no time in testing the slide, only pausing briefly to allow a journalist to take a picture before he plunged into the yellow tube. After only a few weeks, the first Loop Slide in Germany had been tested and certified by the safety experts at TÜV and turned over to AquaMagis for operation. A dream had become reality. Public and media interest was overwhelming, and the waterpark now had a one-of-a-kind attraction.

Today, in 2012 ...

... AquaMagis still enjoys large numbers of visitors and was recently given the highest grade of «very good» by an independent waterpark tester.

Still, this is no reason to rest on one's laurels. Instead, the continuing success offered an expansion opportunity.

AquaMagis proudly opened three new waterslides in the summer of 2012. The Turbo Slide offers riders that special kick with the fully automated Fallstart option, another innovation from Klarer. The system operates automatically requiring no additional personnel. The highest possible safety standards are reached without negatively impacting cost efficiency. To increase the thrill, this Turbo Slide was outfitted with Plexiglas-elements that give the feeling of floating on air while sliding over the park's wave pool. This is pure excitement!





Another highlight is the new Magic Eye®, one of our best-known and most popular water-slides. At a length of 123 m (nearly 404 ft) and a width of 2.50 m (8.2 ft), just the size of the Magic Eye® alone makes an impact. It can be used with single, double or triple inner tubes.

However, we haven't forgotten about the kids! The new Triple Slide gives even the youngest children a chance to get in on the fun and

practice for bigger and better slides in the future. Youngsters set their own speed – from leisurely to racing, the three different lanes allow for a variety of sliding experiences.

We wish AquaMagis continued success and look forward to more exciting projects together.

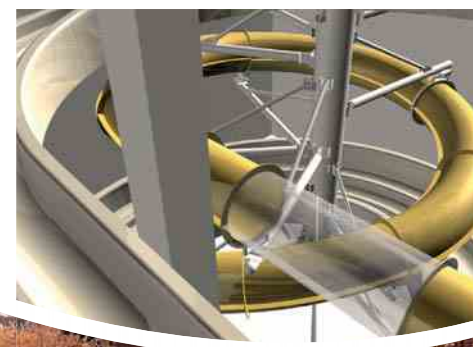
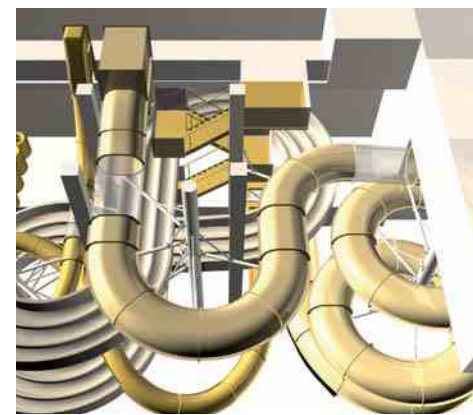
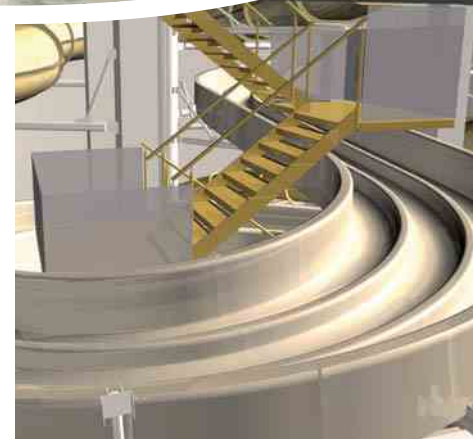
The four-story building, designed in partnership by the architectural firms of Bearth & Deplazes from Chur and Morger + Dettli from Basel, integrates a modern swimming complex with a waterslide park, which is located in a separate area to eliminate noise disturbance, a wellness area as well as a fitness center and outdoor sports center. This new aquatic complex has a bright and inviting Greek temple-themed interior – all set within the existing Kurpark complex in St. Moritz.

Innovative ideas and concepts were a must in the development of this waterpark. Functionality, a varied offering of sliding experiences

with the newest waterslide models, a sound sustainability concept for maintaining the attractiveness of the facility and our high product quality standards were the deciding factors that made Klarer Freizeitanlagen AG rise above its competitors in the selection process.

Three different waterslides with a combined length of over 300 m (984 ft) are planned for the new waterpark. First, the unique Racer Slide, which brings shared water sliding fun to a new level; second, a Magic Tube, which meets the most important criteria for a modern waterslide and can be used as a body slide or raft slide with single or double inner tubes; and finally, a Turbo Slide with Free Fall Launch, to give adrenaline freaks a ride they won't forget!

This concept, which provides maximum waterslide fun in a minimum of space, is an example of expert planning services – from Klarer, of course.

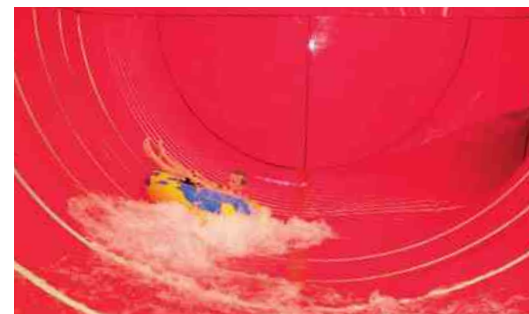
Alpamare in Pfäffikon (SZ) on the shore of beautiful Lake Zurich is an indoor water adventure park of the highest class, known well beyond German-speaking Europe. Opened in 1977, Alpamare remains the largest covered waterpark in Europe. From the very beginning, Klarer Freizeitanlagen AG has been the primary partner for planning and development of new and one-of-a-kind waterslides. This partnership has already moved into the second generation.

Klarer Freizeitanlagen AG was also given the task of creating the newest attraction for Alpamare: The new Cone Slide was developed for this purpose in only six months using our engineering expertise and ingenuity. The slide was developed and tested at our headquarters in Hallau before being installed at Alpamare.

The new King Cone is 150 m (492 ft) long and guarantees riders a thrilling downhill run. The funnel-shaped elements rise majestically

into the sky, drawing curious stares of interest. Those brave enough to jump into the depths will experience a steep downhill ride combined with hair-raising curves and the overwhelming power of the magical Cones.

The Cone Slide can be used with single or double inner tubes. The funnel cones offer both a visual and spatial experience. The enormous size as well as the translucent effects give the Cones a magical feel. Sliders move from side to side following the path of the water between the structures. The Magic Tube is used as a connecting section between the funnels. Space saving, low cost and tried and tested many times, it fulfils the requirements of the Cone Slide more than any other tube slide.
